FESTIVAL ACTIVITY STATIONS

Find a Friend (5-10 minutes)

- Set up as seen in the picture, Players work in groups of 4, 3 on the outside of the area, 1 in the middle
- Each group has one football
- Players pass the ball to the teammate in the middle
- The player receives the ball and passes onto another teammate in the outer circle



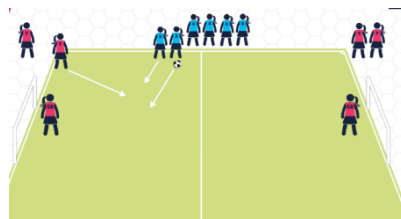
Handball "Zone to Goal" (15-20 minutes)

- Mark an area with a goal and end zone
- 2 teams, one passing the ball to teammates to score in the end zone, and the other team tries to score in the goal
- The teams can throw, bounce, or roll the ball between teammates
- This can also be played by kicking the ball



Risky Business (10-15 minutes)

- Mark an area with a halfway line and a goal at each end
- There are two teams. The defending team divides equally to defend each goal. Attacking team starts at the halfway line ready to play
- The attackers can decide to attack the goal however they wish but they get more points the harder the challenge
- Please see the resources above to see full instructions and how points are scored



3-2-1 (15-20 minutes)

- Mark out a normal football pitch, select two teams
- Each player starts with a value of three
- When they score their first goal it counts as 3 points
- The next goal they score will count as 2 points and any additional goal they score is worth 1 point
- The aim is to work as a team encouraging each teammate to score increasing your goal total



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Through the Gate (5-10 minutes)

- Set out sets of cones to create gates
 - Each player will have a ball
 - Players will have 2 minutes to dribble their ball through as many gates as they can
